Candidates must fulfill the Columbia International School's admissions requirements, including English proficiency and must be able to provide proof of financial need when requested by the admissions office.

These scholarships will be awarded to students for one academic year with renewal options through to graduation.

Following a review of applications received, the principal, upon the recommendation of the Scholarship committee, will select the students to be the recipients of the scholarships.

In selecting the recipients, the Scholarship Committee will apply the following criteria:

- ♦ Individual financial needs of the family
- Country of origin and cultural background
- Fulfillment of the school's admissions requirements
- Applicant's grade level
- Academic achievement and special talents or skills of the applicant
- ♦ Other factors that will support and enrich Columbia International School's educational environment

The school will respect the confidentiality of the scholarship recipients' personal circumstances.
